

# How to digitize audio cassettes

## For Mac

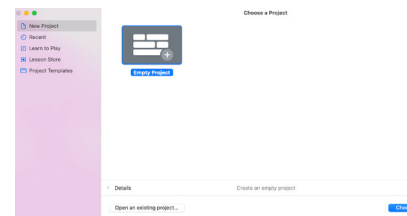
1. Begin by double clicking the **GarageBand** icon on the desktop and putting your record on the turntable. **(Fig. 1)**
2. Attach the silver audio transfer device to the turntable with the RCA cords and set to **Phono..** **(Fig 2)**
3. In the new window, double click **Empty Project.** **(Fig 3)**
4. In the next window, choose the **Microphone** image . **(Fig. 4)**
5. You are ready to record. Put the tone arm on the record player and hit **Record** in Garageband. **(Fig. 5)**
6. You will be able to see your music recording. When you are finished, hit the small gray button next to the green arrow on the top of the screen. This will stop the recording. **(Fig. 6)**
7. To save your music, click on **Share** on the menu bar. You can either export your song or burn it to a CD. **(Fig. 7)**
8. When you export your file, name it, choose where you want to save your work, and save it as an MP3. **(Fig. 8)**

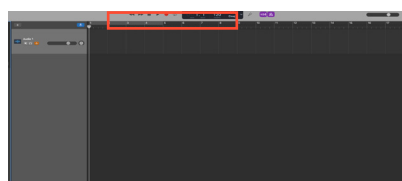

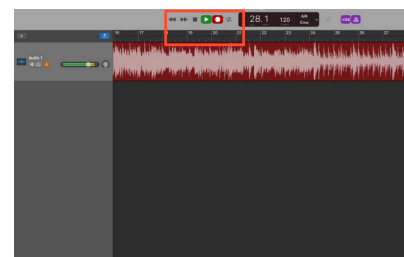

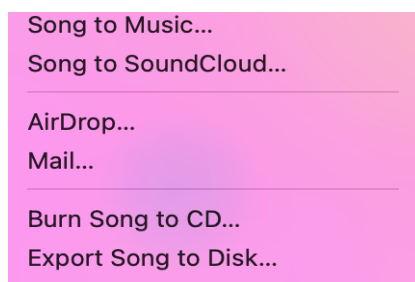

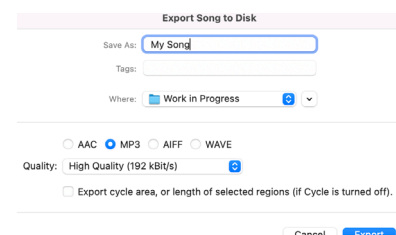
